This was different than the conventional method of sending them to be repaired by a machine shop. He realized that if he could find a way to professionally repair the damage at the customer's location, he could beat the big machine shops at their own game. He developed a method to make these repairs utilizing specific tools and a Mobile Reconditioning Facility.

In 2000, Tom Morris founded Alloy Wheel Repair Specialists and began offering licenses for this business opportunity. He then formed Wheel Repair Solutions International, Inc. to begin franchising this concept. Today, WRSI's technology has evolved to include equipment to straighten bent wheels and to repair machined alloy wheels.

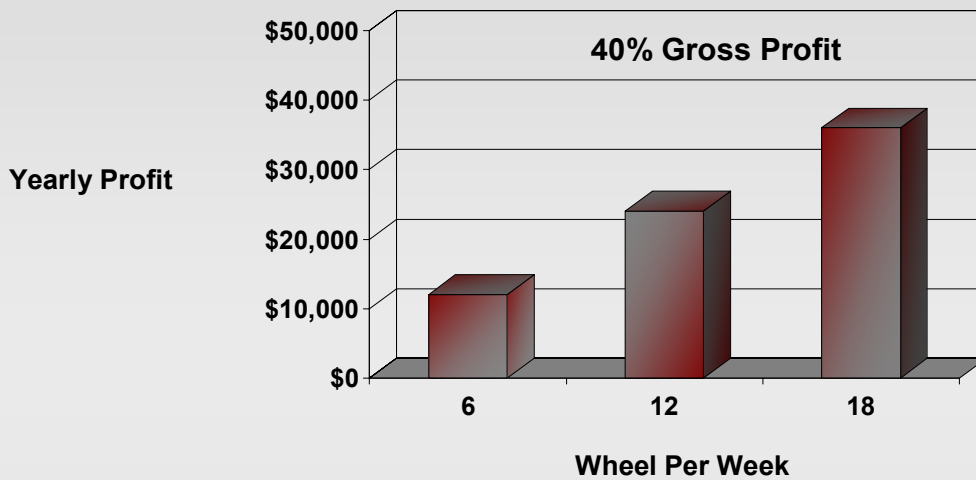

AWRS Warranty

Limited Wheel Repair Warranty

Each Alloy Wheel Repair Specialists business is independently owned and operated under a franchise agreement with Wheel Repair Solutions International, Inc., a Georgia Corporation. The Franchisee that is providing the service to you has agreed to honor a limited warranty on the workmanship of the repair for the life of the wheel. This warranty is only in affect for the original retail consumer purchaser of the service and is non-transferable. If due to the workmanship, and while the vehicle is operated under normal driving conditions, the paint and/or clear coat chips or flakes, or other defects in the surface occur that are determined to be the result of workmanship, then the wheel will be repaired at the sole cost of the AWRS Franchisee. The wheel will not be repaired at no charge if it is determined that, in the best judgment of the technician, the damage occurred due to adverse driving conditions, foreign chemicals or substances making contact with the wheel or any damage resulting from physical contact with any surface made after the repair was completed. Only the identical type of repair as was originally completed will be performed to honor this warranty. The technician will do everything possible to perform the work in a timely manner and at a mutually convenient location.
